

Student Technology Support/Logging In

All EVS students have access to technology (Chromebook/iPad) through LDSB. It is important that students have a good WiFi connection and technology that will support their learning through the MS Teams platform.

Already Have It - If you already have technology (Chromebook or iPad) from LDSB or your own, you are pretty much ready to begin. We recommend that you check to be sure it is working and log into your student email. If everything is fine, wait for a Microsoft (MS) Teams invitation in your mailbox from your teacher.

If your technology is not working you will need to contact ITS Support Centre at 613-417-3559 to diagnose the issue and coordinate repair or replacement.

If you can't remember your log-in information, contact ITS Support Centre at 613-417-3559.

Need it – If you need technology (Chromebook/iPad or a hotspot), you will need to contact EVS staff at (613) 817-9322 and we will coordinate the provision of technology through a school near you. You will be informed when the equipment is ready to be picked up.

Student Log-in information. All EVS students must use their LDSB log-in information (student id and password) to join their classroom. If you do not have this information or cannot remember it, please contact ITS Support Centre at 613-417-3559.

Getting Started on the First Day Students must log-on to their LDSB student account. As indicated above, the EVS uses MS Teams for its instructional platform. Students should have received an invitation to join the MS Teams meeting for their classroom. Click on the join button in that invitation. When students join the meeting, they should mute their microphone until instructed to do otherwise by the teacher. Also check to see whether your camera is on or off. If students have not received an invitation to join a meeting and/or you have an invitation but cannot join the classroom meeting, please contact the classroom teacher.
